Greenville P.D. Arrests Pendleton Man for Criminal Solicitation of a Minor

Columbia - Attorney General Alan Wilson announced today that on February 9, 2011, the Greenville Police Department, with assistance from the Anderson County Sheriffs' Office, arrested Corey Damon Crocker, 31, of 120 McAlister in Pendleton, SC.

Both agencies involved with the arrest are members of the Attorney General's Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force.

Arrest warrants allege Crocker engaged in online conversations of a sexual nature and sent graphic images to a person he believed to be a minor, who was actually an undercover officer with the Greenville Police Department.

Crocker was arrested on one (1) count of Criminal Solicitation of a Minor (§16-15-342), a felony offense punishable by up to ten (10) years imprisonment; one (1) count of Dissemination of Obscene Material to a Minor (§16-15-345), a felony offense punishable by up to ten (10) years imprisonment. He was released on \$10,000 bond on each charge.

The case will be prosecuted by the Attorney General's Office.

Wilson stressed that all defendants are presumed innocent unless and until they are proven guilty in a court of law.
