Spartanburg Sheriff Arrests Boiling Springs Man on Child Pornography

Columbia - Attorney General Alan Wilson announced today that Seth Glenn Estey, 24, of 8171 2nd Street in Boiling Springs, South Carolina was arrested on February 15, 2011, by the Spartanburg County Sheriff's Office on child pornography charges.

The Spartanburg County Sheriff's Office is a member of the Attorney General's Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force. Task Force investigators have received training on the use of special software to conduct undercover investigations related to the sharing of child pornography on peer-to-peer (file sharing) networks.

Estey is charged with one (1) count of Sexual Exploitation of a Minor (§16-15-405), 3rd Degree, a felony offense punishable by up to ten (10) years imprisonment.

Estey is charged with sharing graphic digital photographs and/or videos over the internet depicting children engaged in a sexual nature. Estey's computers were seized for forensic examination. Files containing the pornographic images were found on that computer.

The case will be prosecuted by the Attorney General's Office.

Wilson stressed that all defendants are presumed innocent unless and until they are proven guilty in a court of law.
