## **LITTLE RIVER MAN ARRESTED ON CHILD PORNOGRAPHY CHARGES**

(COLUMBIA, S.C.) South Carolina Attorney General Alan Wilson announced the arrest of James Fredrick Bullard (DOB: 08/19/1956) of Little River, S.C. on sixteen (16) counts involving the sexual exploitation of minors. The 15th Judicial Circuit, a member of the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force, made the arrest.

The ICAC Task Force received a referral from investigators at the Berkeley County Sheriff's Office (also an ICAC Task Force member) that images depicting children engaged in sexual activity had been disseminated from an account traced to Bullard's residence. A search warrant was executed, and Bullard was arrested on February 20, 2014.

Bullard admitted to downloading child pornography. He is charged with sixteen (16) counts of Sexual Exploitation of a Minor second degree (§16-15-405), a felony offense punishable by up to ten (10) years imprisonment on each count.

The case will be prosecuted by the Attorney General's Office.

Attorney General Wilson stressed all defendants are presumed innocent unless and until they are proven guilty in a court of law.
