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## **Gable Man Convicted on Ten Counts of Medicaid Provider Fraud**

(COLUMBIA, S.C.) Willie Lee Bethune of Gable, South Carolina was convicted on ten (10) counts of Medicaid fraud in Richland General Sessions Court on April 10, 2014.

The fraud occurred in 2010, when Bethune worked for Youth Options, which had an agreement to provide counseling services to students in Clarendon School District One. No service was provided.

Judge Robert Hood sentenced Bethune to one year in jail for each count, with nine of them to run concurrent with the first year.

The case was prosecuted by Senior Assistant Attorney General Ken Moore. The investigation was conducted by the Medicaid Provider Fraud Control Unit of the Attorney General's Office.

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
