CHARLESTON MAN ARRESTED ON CHILD PORNOGRAPHY CHARGE

(COLUMBIA, S.C.) South Carolina Attorney General Alan Wilson announced the arrest of Adam Guy Noisette (DOB: 01/06/1992) of Charleston, S.C. on one (1) count involving the sexual exploitation of a minor. The Charleston County Sheriff's Office, a member of the Attorney General's Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force, made the arrest.

Noisette was involved in a prior Charleston County investigation and, during the investigation, investigators discovered several photographs of minors in sexually suggestive poses.

Noisette was arrested on August 5, 2014 and charged with one (1) count of Sexual Exploitation of a Minor third degree (§16-15-410), a felony offense punishable by up to ten (10) years imprisonment. Three pieces of electronic equipment were seized.

The case will be prosecuted by the Attorney General's Office.

Attorney General Wilson stressed all defendants are presumed innocent unless and until they are proven guilty in a court of law.
