## Vance Man Arrested for Sexual Exploitation of Minors

(COLUMBIA, S.C.) South Carolina Attorney General Alan Wilson announced the arrest of Jahmarius Davis (DOB: 1995) of Vance, South Carolina on eight (8) charges connected to sexual exploitation of minors. The South Carolina Law Enforcement Division (SLED), a member of the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force, made the arrest. Assistance was provided by the Oakland (Tennessee) Police Department.

Investigators say Davis developed online relationships with two minors in Tennessee and engaged in sexually explicit conversations with them, which included sexually explicit photos.

Davis was arrested on July 30, 2015. Computer-related media was seized for further examination.

Davis was charged with two (2) counts of Criminal Solicitation of a Minor (§16-15-342), a felony offense punishable by up to ten (10) years imprisonment on each count; two (2) counts of Sexual Exploitation of a Minor, first degree, (§16-15-395), a felony offense punishable by up to twenty (20) years imprisonment on each count; two (2) counts of Sexual Exploitation of a Minor, second degree (§16-3-405), a felony offense punishable by up to ten (10) years imprisonment on each count; two (2) counts of Sexual Exploitation of a Minor, third degree (§16-15-410), a felony offense punishable by up to ten (10) years imprisonment on each count; and two (2) counts of Dissemination of Obscene Material to a Person Under Age 18 (§16-3-345), a felony offense punishable by up to ten (10) years imprisonment on each count.

The case will be prosecuted by the Attorney General's Office.

Attorney General Wilson stressed all defendants are presumed innocent unless and until they are proven guilty in a court of law.
