## **Effingham Man Arrested on Criminal Sexual Conduct with a Minor charge**

(COLUMBIA, S.C.) South Carolina Attorney General Alan Wilson announced the arrest of Jarvis Quadry Dubose (DOB: 1993) of Effingham, South Carolina on one (1) charge connected to sexual exploitation of minors. The City of Florence Police Department, a member of the state's Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force, made the arrest.

Dubose met the victim through social media, made arrangements to meet in person and then engaged in sexual activity with the minor.

Dubose was arrested on September 18, 2015. He is charged with one (1) count of Criminal Sexual Conduct with a Minor, second degree (§16-3-655(B)(1)), a felony offense punishable by up to twenty (20) years imprisonment and Sex Offender Registry status.

The case will be prosecuted by the Attorney General's Office.

Attorney General Wilson stressed all defendants are presumed innocent unless and until they are proven guilty in a court of law.
