## Lake Wylie Man Arrested on Child Pornography Charges

**(COLUMBIA, S.C.)** South Carolina Attorney General Alan Wilson announced the arrest of Wallace Wayne Malcolm (DOB: 05/23/1951) of Lake Wylie, S.C. on ten (10) counts involving the sexual exploitation of a minor. The York County Sheriff's Office, a member of the S.C. Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force, made the arrest. Assistance was provided by the Gastonia (North Carolina) Police Department.

Investigators say that in December 2014, Malcolm was involved in exchanging child pornography via peer-to-peer file sharing.

A search warrant was obtained and executed at Malcolm's residence on January 8, 2015. Electronic devices were seized from the residence for examination.

Malcolm was arrested on January 26, 2015, and charged with ten (10) counts of Sexual Exploitation of a Minor, third degree (§16-15-410), a felony offense punishable by up to ten (10) years imprisonment.

The case will be prosecuted by the Attorney General's Office.

Attorney General Wilson stressed all defendants are presumed innocent unless and until they are proven guilty in a court of law.
