Bishopville Man Arrested on Child Pornography Charge

(COLUMBIA, S.C.) South Carolina Attorney General Alan Wilson announced the arrest of Wesley Woodham Randall (DOB 1987) of Bishopville, S.C. on one (1) count involving the sexual exploitation of minors. The South Carolina Attorney General's Office, a member of the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force, made the arrest. The Lee County Sheriff's Office and Bishopville Police Department assisted with the investigation.

Investigators say Randall was involved in exchanging child pornography via peer-to-peer file sharing.

Randall was arrested on March 13, 2015 and charged with one (1) count of Sexual Exploitation of a Minor second degree (§16-15-405), a felony offense punishable by up to ten (10) years imprisonment on each count. A computer was seized for forensic examination. Bond was set at \$5,000.

The case will be prosecuted by the Attorney General's Office.

Attorney General Wilson stressed all defendants are presumed innocent unless and until they are proven guilty in a court of law.
