Dear Mr. Pulliam:

Mr. Cook has referred your recent letter to me for reply. You have raised a question as to whether or not a member of the Manufactured Housing Board is a qualified member of the Board in that at the time of his appointment he was not a licensed mobile home retail salesman.

Our Office has issued several prior opinions specifically addressed to this question in which we stated that a person must be qualified at the time he is appointed. You have included some of these prior opinions with your letter. Also see attached copies of two additional previous opinions of this Office. (June 10, 1982 letter of James Holly to George L. Schroeder, letter of February 17, 1983 of Treva Ashworth to the Honorable C. Alex Harvin, III.) These letters would still represent the opinion of this Office as to the issues you have raised.
