Dear Commissioner Jolly:

In a recent letter you requested an opinion as to whether individual members of the State Real Estate Commission should be notified of complaints against brokers from their congressional districts upon receipt of such complaints by the Commission office.

In an opinion of this Office dated September 22, 1980 it was stated that members of the Real Estate Commission should not be so notified. Please be advised that while the statute cited in the opinion has been amended to increase the number of commissioners required for a hearing, the basis for the referenced opinion remains valid. The requirement that the member from the congressional district in which the appellant resides attend the appellant's hearing still remains.
