By your letter of October 29, 1984, you have asked the opinion of this Office on whether a member of the General Assembly may serve as one of the members of the Coastal Council elected by the General Assembly to represent one of the congressional districts. Enclosed is a copy of an opinion dated June 2, 1977, written by former Attorney General Daniel McLeod, concluding that a member of the General Assembly may not be elected or appointed to serve as one of the members of the Coastal Council representing a congressional district.
