This opinion letter is forwarded to you to serve as compliance with Section 404.2104(b), as listed in the Federal Register, Volume 46, Number 198, Proposed Rules, Wednesday, October 14, 1981.

The South Carolina Commission for the Blind was created pursuant to [Section 43-25-10 of the Code](#) of Laws of the State of South Carolina (1976). Under that same citation, the Commission was given authority to appoint a Commissioner to fill the duties prescribed by the Commission. Section 43-25-30 prescribes the powers and duties of the Commission, among which is the authority to apply for, receive, and expend money from both State and Federal sources, and to serve as the authorized Rehabilitation Agency for the blind in the State of South Carolina.
