Dear Mr. Brice:

Mr. McLeod has referred your recent letter concerning a change in the method of electing municipal officers to me. You have requested we advise you if these changes should be filed with the Office of the Secretary of State.

State law requires the initial form and method of election to be filed with the Secretary of State. South Carolina Code of Laws, 1976, Section 5-15-30. There is no statutory requirement that this information be updated; but, it would appear advisable in order that the Secretary of State have on file the most recent information on the status of the method of election in your city.
