Dear Bill:

Please accept my apologies for the delay in providing this letter confirming our telephone conversation two weeks ago.

As stated in that conversation, it is our opinion that there is no prohibition against your providing copies of the workpapers prepared by your Office, pursuant to the audit of concessionaires in connection with the University of South Carolina athletic events. The Tax Commission has customarily exchanged such information with the Internal Revenue Service in appropriate cases and we find no prohibition against this practice. The information you would be providing is pursuant to the audit of public contracts, and is not a disclosure of individual tax returns.
