Dear Ms. Gardner:

Your letter of August 13, 1981, to the Attorney General has been referred to me for an appropriate response. [Section 8-11-80 of the South Carolina Code of Laws \(1976\)](#) permit the Comptroller General on request by the employee to make payroll deductions for payment of premiums for life, hospital and such other types of insurance plans provided there are more than 500 state employees to participate in any particular plan. However, since the Comptroller General does not handle the payrolls for local school districts, this statute would not be applicable to your particular question. I would suggest that you contact the Finance Officer for the Dorchester County School System to determine if the school district by county ordinance or otherwise has authorized such payroll deductions.
