In response to your request for an opinion from this Office as to the appointment of the Sumter County Master-in-Equity, my opinion is that the Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, appoints him by virtue of the provisions of Section 15-1802, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1962, as amended. You might note that the office of master-in-equity in South Carolina is to be abolished on July 1, 1979, and the jurisdiction of such court devolved upon the unified court system pursuant to Article VII, Section 5 of Act No. 690 of 1976. 59 STAT. 1859 (1976).
