You have asked whether the constitutional provision prohibiting dual office holding would be violated by your serving as City Attorney for the Town of Ware Shoals while simultaneously serving on the State Highway Commission.

This Office has previously issued opinions that each of the questioned positions is an office for dual office holding purposes. Therefore, it is the opinion of this Office that the dual office holding provision would be violated by simultaneously serving on the State Highway Commission and as City Attorney for the Town of Ware Shoals.
