You have asked this Office to explain to you why a question concerning a tuition grant applicant's race appears on the tuition grant form.

Mr. Lane Ligon of the South Carolina Tuition Grants Agency informed me that while the requested information has no bearing on the individual's eligibility for a tuition grant, the information is requested so that the Grants Agency can send statistical data to the National Association of State Scholarship and State Grant Programs, which publishes such statistics from all states and six territories.
