Mauldin Man Arrested on Child Pornography Charges

(COLUMBIA, S.C.) South Carolina Attorney General Alan Wilson announced the arrest of Eric Randolph Hollandsworth (DOB: 1987) of Mauldin, S.C., on fifty-three (53) charges connected to sexual exploitation of minors. The City of Mauldin Police Department, a member of the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force, made in the arrest.

Investigators state that Hollandsworth sent child pornography via social media.

Hollandsworth was arrested on April 6, 2016. He is charged with thirty-two (32) counts of Sexual Exploitation of a Minor, Second Degree (§16-15-405), a felony offense punishable by up to (10) years imprisonment on each count; and with twenty-one (21) counts of Sexual Exploitation of a Minor, Third Degree (§16-15-410), a felony offense punishable by up to ten (10) years imprisonment on each count.

The case will be prosecuted by the Attorney General's Office.

Attorney General Wilson stressed all defendants are presumed innocent unless and until they are proven guilty in a court of law.
