Orangeburg Man Arrested on Child Pornography Charge

(COLUMBIA, S.C.) South Carolina Attorney General Alan Wilson announced the arrest of Moses Franklin Cutter III (DOB: 1971) of Orangeburg, S.C., on one (1) charge connected to sexual exploitation of minors. Investigators with the South Carolina Attorney General's Office made the arrest. The Orangeburg County Sheriff's Office, a member of the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force, assisted in the arrest.

Investigators state that Cutter was involved in sharing child pornography via a file-sharing network.

Cutter was arrested on May 5, 2016. He is charged with one (1) count of Sexual Exploitation of a Minor, Second Degree (§16-15-405), a felony offense punishable by up to (10) years imprisonment.

The case will be prosecuted by the Attorney General's Office.

Attorney General Wilson stressed all defendants are presumed innocent unless and until they are proven guilty in a court of law.
