Anderson Man Arrested on Child Pornography Charges

(COLUMBIA, S.C.) South Carolina Attorney General Alan Wilson announced the arrest of Larry Ray Vickery (DOB: 1972) of Anderson, S.C., on twenty-seven (27) charges connected to sexual exploitation of minors. Investigators with the South Carolina Attorney General's Office made the arrest. The Anderson County Sheriff's Office, a member of the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force, assisted in the arrest.

Investigators state that Vickery was involved in selling child pornography via the internet.

Vickery was arrested on May 11, 2016. He is charged with twenty-one (21) counts of Sexual Exploitation of a Minor, Second Degree (§16-15-405), a felony offense punishable by up to (10) years imprisonment; and with six (6) counts of Sexual Exploitation of a Minor, Third Degree (§16-15-410), a felony offense punishable by up to ten (10) years imprisonment on each count.

The case will be prosecuted by the Attorney General's Office.

Attorney General Wilson stressed all defendants are presumed innocent unless and until they are proven guilty in a court of law.
