North Carolina Man Arrested on Attempted Criminal Sexual Conduct with a Minor Charge

(COLUMBIA, S.C.) South Carolina Attorney General Alan Wilson announced the arrest of David Olin Cameron (DOB: 1987) of Spring Lake, N.C., on one (1) charge connected to sexual exploitation of minors. The Aiken County Sheriff's Office, a member of the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force, made the arrest.

Investigators state that Cameron traveled to Aiken to solicit sex from a minor child.

Cameron was arrested on May 19, 2016. He is charged with one (1) count of Attempted Criminal Sexual Conduct with a Minor, (§16-3-655), a felony offense punishable by up to 20 years imprisonment.

The case will be prosecuted by the Attorney General's Office.

Attorney General Wilson stressed all defendants are presumed innocent unless and until they are proven guilty in a court of law.
