Dear Mr. Gressette:

You have requested this Office to advise you as to the correct boundaries of the Town of St. Matthews. You have informed us that in 1905 an election was held to extend the Town limits into an area which would be approximately a square. In 1937 the boundaries were changed to approximately a circle with a radius of three-fourths of a mile.

Assuming that the proper and legal requirements for establishing the limits of the Town were followed, the last ordinance would control and would designate the proper boundaries of the Town.
