Dear Mr. McCall:

You have inquired whether a device called the 'Paralyzer' is permitted to be sold in the State of South Carolina.

I advise that, in my opinion, this device is prohibited from possession, use, sale, etc., by the terms of Section 16-147 of the Code of Laws for 1962. The device is very similar to another device which has been the subject of a previous opinion by this Office and the reasoning of that opinion is applicable to the 'Paralyzer.' A copy of the opinion is herewith enclosed.
