Your letter of March 18 inquires your rights concerning condemnation of property for the City of Lancaster.

Private property may be taken by condemnation proceedings providing just compensation is paid therefor. The procedure for such condemnation or eminent domain is set forth in the laws of the State and I refer you to the City Attorney of Lancaster for any further details on the matter. I am sure that you realize that this lies completely within his jurisdiction and he is the logical one whom you should contact.
