You have requested an opinion from this Office as to whether the Abbeville County Board of Commissioners presently has the recommendatory power with regard to the appointment of the members of the Abbeville County Board of Voter Registration.

As you will note, my opinion is that the Board of Commissioners presently has the recommendatory power as to the Abbeville Board of Voter Registration pursuant to Act No. 32 of 1973. 58 STAT. 28 (1973).
