This is to advise that we concur with your conclusion that Circuit Court Rule 87 increases the number of foreign countries in which depositions may be taken.

In such additional countries depositions 'may be taken before a Notary Public or any other officer authorized under the law of the jurisdiction where taken to administer oaths.' Circuit Court Rule 87.
