Dear Mr. Campbell:

Thank you for your letter of May 18, 1976, inquiring if the mailing list for the South Carolina Department of Agriculture's publication 'The Market Bulletin' is public information.

I advise that, in my opinion, the mailing list is public information and that it is accessible to inspection and copying by the public. The Department of Agriculture is not required to furnish copies but its officials inform me that they will permit the inspection and copying of the documents at reasonable times, as the law requires. The Department's officials state also that they do not consider that such access to the mailing list is contrary to the public interest and therefore do not interpose any objection to the right to inspection and copying.
