Mr. Poliakoff of this Office prepared an opinion in answer to your request concerning your authority to withdraw the veto of a bill after the expiration of the five-day constitutional period but before the General Assembly had acted upon the veto.

The letter of Mr. Poliakoff was read to me over the telephone and I directed that it be sent to you immediately because I am in concurrence with the views expressed in it.
