Reference is made to letter to you dated April 11, 1972, wherein Mr. C. W. F. Spencer, Jr., as attorney for the City of Rock Hill, stated his opinion confirming the power of the City of Rock Hill, under pertinent statutes of the State of South Carolina, to comply with the provisions of Public Law 91-646, 84 STAT. 1894, entitled 'Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970.'

The statutes and cases cited in Mr. Spencer's letter of April 11, 1972, clearly support the opinions therein expressed, and we therefore concur in the opinion of Mr. Spencer that the City of Rock Hill has sufficient statutory authority to comply with and implement the provisions of Public Law 91-646, in the particulars set forth in the final paragraph, page 3, of Mr. Spencer's letter.
