That DEAN MORRIS WOLVINGTON JR., AMANDA RAYE MASSENGALE, RAPHPEL MANWEL SUBER, and other persons whose names are both known and unknown to the State Grand Jury, did in Greenville County, South Carolina, on or about March 20, 2022, combine with another person for the purpose of accomplishing an unlawful object or lawful object by unlawful means, to wit: despite the substantial risk of overdose, defendants conspired to distribute Fentanyl to the victim, Emily Turner, which resulting in the victim's death.

All in violation of Section 16-17-410 of the South Carolina Code, and such conduct not

having been authorized by law; and such conduct involving and arising out of and in

connection with a crime involving narcotics, dangerous drugs, or controlled substances, and

such crime being of a multi-county nature and having transpired and having significance in

more than one county of this State.


