You have requested that this office render an opinion as to the legality of the contract known as Agreement made 1 March 1970 between Aerial Services Corporation, and Virginia Corporation, and Buck Creek (S. C.) Watershed Conservation District pertaining to the treatment and maintenance of diten banks in Horry County.

A review of this contract indicates that it is a binding contract and legally enforceble against either of the parties thereto. Should either party breach this contract by failing to perform in accordance the with, a cause of action will be created on behalf of the other party for specific performance including any damages incurred as a result of such breach.
