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Request for IAR Continuing Education Exemption

Requests must be received by the Securities Division by November 15 of the year for which the exemption is requested. Exemptions are not effective until you receive confirmation from the Securities Division.

To qualify for an Exemption from Investment Adviser Representative (IAR) Continuing Education (IAR CE), in accordance with Order 25002, a registrant must meet the following criteria:

- Twenty-five (25) years or more of licensure as an IAR under §35-1-404 in South Carolina; and
- Age sixty-five (65) or more (submit a copy of state/federal ID with date of birth with form).

I also understand that failure to keep my continuing education current may make me ineligible to participate in the IAR Exam Validity Extension Program (Order Number 24004) in the future if I do not meet the IAR CE requirements of that program.
