Re: U.S. Senate Special Republican Primary Runoff

Dear Members of the South Carolina State Election Commission,

As South Carolina prepares for the August 25 U.S. Senate Special Republican Primary Runoff, I respectfully ask the State Election Commission and county election offices to provide voters with as much advance notice as possible of any precinct consolidations or polling-place changes.

Because this special election is being conducted on a compressed timeline, some changes may be necessary, but voters should not be surprised on Election Day. Any changes should be finalized and clearly communicated as early as possible, including through mailed notices, election websites, public notices, and signage at former polling locations.

With early voting beginning August 19, South Carolinians deserve to know where they are supposed to vote before voting begins. Clear and timely notice will reduce confusion and help maintain confidence in the election process.
