As the Chief Legal Officers of the fourteen undersigned states, we are writing to express our strong support for the “Safeguarding Women from Chemical Abortion Act.”

The widespread distribution of mifepristone, used primarily for chemical abortions, raises serious concerns for states tasked with protecting the health and safety of our citizens. This distribution has become more rampant thanks in large part to mail-order channels and a reduction in federal safeguards.


