Dear Dr. Murtagh:

It is the opinion of this Office, on and after the date July 1, 1972, State agencies of South Carolina and political subdivisions thereof can comply with the requirements of the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970 (Public Law 91-646).

The act upon which this conclusion is based is Act No. R-1524, approved by the Governor of South Carolina on the 31st day of May, 1972. By Section 8 of the said act, its provisions 'become effective on July 1, 1972, or upon its approval by the Governor, whichever comes later.' A copy of the statute referred to is hereto annexed.

It is the opinion of this Office that the statute in question also places the State of South Carolina in compliance with applicable provisions of the Land and Water Conservation Fund Program.
