Dear Mr. Rembert:

In answer to your recent inquiry addressed to the Attorney General, this is to advise that the General Assembly by Act R 1341, approved May 6, 1972, abolished the requirement that ballots not be counted in multi-seat races if the voter marks less than the total number of candidates to be elected. A person's ballot will still not be counted for a particular office if he votes for more candidates than the total number to be elected.
