Dear Miss Elliot:

The legal age to enter into a billiard room or parlor unless accompanied by a parent or with the written consent of a parent is twenty-one years of age, South Carolina Code of Laws of 1962 § 5-513. The legal age to drink beer is eighteen years of age, South Carolina Code of Laws of 1962, § 4-213. There seems to be nothing inconsistent in the proposition that one under the age of twenty-one with written consent of his parent can enter a billiard parlor where beer is offered for sale.
