In your letter of June 27, 1972, you inquired whether or not a Sheriff's deputy may serve a Mayor's warrant which has been countersigned by a Magistrate. § 43-221 <u>Code of Laws of South Carolina</u>, 1962, as amended, states that a Mayor's warrant may be endorsed by the Magistrate and that it shall then be executed by the Magistrate's constable or the sheriff of the county of the endorsing Magistrate.
