Thank you for your letter of May 23, 1972, inquiring if a county may validly furnish any type of assistance to the Solicitor's Office or supplement the expenditure for equipment, personnel or supplies for this Office.

In my opinion, such action is within the authority of the counties under the provisions of the Constitution of this State, specifically Article 10, Section 6 thereof. The common practice in areas of the State in this regard evidences the legislative construction that the Constitution clearly permits this.
