The South Carolina Office of the Attorney General is pleased to announce that the National Attorneys General Training & Research Institute (NAGTRI) of the National Association of Attorneys General (NAAG) and the Upper Midwest Community Policing Institute (UMCPI) are conducting a *tuition-free*, one and one-half day training for prosecutors and investigators on **Human Trafficking**. The training will be limited to prosecutors and investigators. The first day will include an overview of human trafficking, an introduction to the legal framework – international, national, and state – regarding trafficking in persons, partnership models, victim issues, investigatory and interviewing techniques, and prosecutorial theories and practices. The second day will include a discussion on prosecutorial theories and practices, an ethics discussion based on a human trafficking case study, and a workshop on developing a human trafficking prosecution. Funding for this program has been generously provided by the Bureau of Justice Assistance, U.S. Department of Justice.

The training will take place on January 27 and 28, 2014 at the Bill Rogers Community Center located at 4900 Broad River Road, Columbia, SC 29210, in front of the Department of Juvenile Justice. Attendees will be responsible for paying for their own food and transportation expenses. Please see the attached draft agenda for more details.

There will be a limited number of scholarships for hotel accommodations provided to those who live more than 50 miles away.
