Dear Senator Gilbert:

In a letter to this Office you questioned whether special legislation for counties which provided for locations for magistrates has been superseded.

In an opinion of this Office issued March 6, 1990, a copy of which is enclosed, it was stated that Section 22-8-40 of the Code sets forth the manner of determining the number of magistrates in a county but does not provide for the location of any particular magistrate. The opinion further stated
