Dear Mr. Elam:

By your letter of June 11, 1991, you have asked for the opinion of this Office as to the constitutionality of S.1013, R-237, an act relating to the Spartanburg Commission on Higher Education. Because education is a matter to be addressed by the General Assembly rather than at the county level, see Art. XI, § 3 of the State Constitution, it is our opinion that this act would most probably be constitutional. See also Op. Atty. Gen. dated April 24, 1980 (matters concerning appointments to the Spartanburg County Commission on Higher Education should continue to rest with the legislature under Art. XI, § 3).
