Dear Mr. Jacks:

You ask whether an individual may simultaneously serve as a city or county fireman and as a county coroner. Please be advised that recent State Constitutional amendments provide that dual office holding limitations no longer apply to members of lawfully and regularly organized fire departments. See Article III, Section 24, Article VI, Section 3 and Article XVII, Section 1A of the South Carolina Constitution. See also Ops. Atty. Gen dated June 28, 1990 and January 31, 1989.

As to any potential conflict of interest or other ethical considerations, I would respectfully direct you to the Ethics Commission.
