Dear Mr. Hayes:

You have asked this office to advise you as to whether the teachers' salary table attached to your letter of December 16, 1987 sets forth the required minimum salary for teachers in the Rock Hill school district for the 1987-88 school year based upon the opinion of this office dated December 9, 1987. We have not verified the figures set forth in the table, but the table appears to be consistent with the December 9th opinion. The table determines the salaries for teachers having eighteen and nineteen years of experience by adding the required state minimum salary schedule amount to a local supplement amount that is adjusted to equal the dollar amount of local supplements paid for those experience levels in the previous school year.
