SUBJECT:

Public Records - Review By The South Carolina Legislative Audit Council Of Tax Commission Records Relating To Criminal Investigations.

SYLLABUS:

The Legislative Audit Council has access to all records of the South Carolina Tax Commission, including those that relate to an investigation of a criminal offense.

QUESTION: May the Commission make available its records to the South Carolina Legislative Council in tax investigations that involve a criminal offense?

APPLICABLE LAW: Section 16, Part II of Act 201, Acts of 1985.

#### DISCUSSION:

The section provides access and review authority to the Council for all records of the Tax Commission except those made confidential by other statutes. Insofar as those confidential records are involved, the Court of Common Pleas of Richland County has ordered the access for such records. The applicable language of the section is that:

"For purposes of carrying out its audit duties, ... the Legislative Audit Council shall have access to the records and facilities of every state agency during that agency's operating hours with the exception of reports and returns of the South Carolina Tax Commission as provided in Sections 12-7-1680 and 12-35-1530."

"In the performance of their audit duties, Legislative Audit Council staff members are subject to the statutory provisions and penalties regarding confidentiality of records of the agency under review."

Access to the Tax Commission records is thus given to the Legislative Audit Council. There is no exception for those records that relate to an investigation for a criminal offense.

# CONCLUSION:

The Legislative Audit Council has access to all records of the South Carolina Tax Commission, including those that relate to an investigation of a criminal offense.
