Dear Representative Martin.

You have requested an opinion on whether Pickens County is legally obligated to obey Act No. 383, South Carolina Acts and Joint Resolutions, 1912, which provide that all roads and highways forming the whole or any part of the regular route of any rural delivery mail carrier shall be maintained at public expense. It does not appear that this special act has been repealed. Therefore, it would still be applicable to Pickens County. However, insofar as it is a special law, the County Council would be empowered to enact an ordinance which could repeal or amend this requirement of law. § 3, Act No. 383, South Carolina Acts and Joint Resolutions, 1975.
