Dear Mr. Hyman:

In response to your request for an opinion from this Office regarding the Florence City-County Airport Commission (Commission), I am enclosing copies of earlier opinions directed to Senator Thomas E. Smith, Jr., which discuss, <u>inter alia</u>, the recommendatory powers of the Florence County Council with respect to the Commission. As you will note, inasmuch as there is a question as to whether or not the Commission is purely a county board to which Section 4-9-170, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, as amended, and Act No. 27 of 1975 [59 STAT. 23 (1975)] are applicable, and inasmuch as the legislation creating the Commission may not be a law 'relating to' Florence County within the meaning of SECTION 3 of Act No. 283 of 1975, the 'home rule' legislation, I would recommend that a declaratory judgment pursuant to Sections 15-53-10 <u>et seq.</u>, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1976, as amended, be sought in order to reach a definitive resolution.
