You have recently asked this Office for its opinion about the continued vitality of the attached Consent Order, subsequent to the statutory amendments which became effective July 18, 1978. The Consent Order provides:

This Consent Order is premised upon Sections 9-451 to 9-455 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina (Cum. Supp. 1975) as presently enacted, which delineate the duties and responsibilities of the Commission.

It is the opinion of this Office that since the duties and responsibilities of the Commission, now outlined in [Section 1-15-40, 1976 Code of Laws of South Carolina](#), have been enlarged to include the power to 'disseminate pertinent material relating to the rights, responsibilities and status of women' the Consent Order is no longer effective.
